

Transfer Guide: MCC Liberal Arts Transfer – Associate of Arts (LATAA) to UNO Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education – Inclusive Educator Concentration (2025)

This degree strengthens foundation skills, provides a broad understanding, and develops thinking skills as students prepare for advanced studies in Communication, Education, Fine Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences. Students completing this degree can transfer their credits into a bachelor's degree program at a four-year institution.

Every effort has been made to provide accurate information on suggested courses; however, it is the students' responsibility to consult with the institution they plan to transfer to, ensuring that the courses fit into their intended plan of study.

MCC students intending to transfer to UNO to complete their Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education – Inclusive Educator Concentration have two options:

OPTION 1: Follow the pathway outlined below. Due to UNO's academic course sequence, this option is designed as a five-year plan: two years at MCC followed by three years at UNO.

OPTION 2: Transfer to UNO after completing your first year at MCC. Because of the sequencing of upper-division courses at UNO, students who wish to graduate in four years (one year at MCC and three years at UNO) must transfer after their first year at MCC. Students who choose this option may still be able to earn an associate degree from MCC through reverse transfer. Courses recommended for completion at MCC prior to transfer appear at the end of this guide.
